MSC beat Cavaliers

Friday's match was rained off. The British Airways Cavaliers and Marsa Sports Club Cricketers, after inspecting the field following heavy rain, decided conditions were not fit for play. The Cavaliers took the opportunity to use the practice nets.

In Saturday's 35 over game MCS beat the Cavaliers by 37 runs. Very accurate bowling by the Cavaliers kept MSC guessing and pegged down to a run rate of four an over, with Grima 27, Appleyard 26 and J. Dixon 24 as top scorers.

For Cavaliers Potter took three for 13, Mushtaq two for 39 and Vino, Sultan and Purser each took a wicket.

In reply Cavaliers were 110 for nine, top scorers Potter 29, Climpson 27, while for MSC Cassius took two for seven, Dixon two for 10 and W. Glynn two for 45. Azzopardi and Appleyard each took a wicket. The Cavaliers fell to five catches, two stumpings, a run out and one clean bowled.

On Sunday Cavaliers batted first ad in 35 overs lost only four wickets for 160 runs. Top scorers were Sultan with 49 including six fours, Potter 39, Mushtaq 22 and Kapoor 21. Tobias, Caruana and Felice each took a wicket.

In reply, tight bowling limited MSC to late scoring, only 16 off the first eight overs and 67 off 22 overs. Opener J. Dixon made a valuable 68 out of MSC's total of 152 for eight.

For Cavaliers Vino took three for 19, Potter two for 47, Newbury

and Mushtaq one each. For MSC only three of Saturday's winning side played again on Sunday.

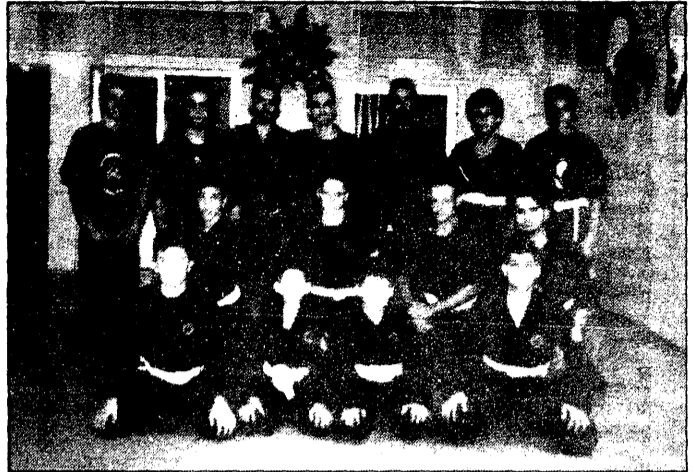

First Ninja group in Malta

September 26 was a special day for a group of youths who for the past year trained hard to become the first Ninja group on the island under the authorisation of the London Bujinkan Brian Dojo, which is one of the best Ninja schools in Europe.

It was the turn of Mr Brian Whitaker, 3rd Dan instructor to visit Malta after Mr Alfred Galea, the instructor of the Malta group, had attended for training lessons in London last January.

Their dream came true when Mr Whitaker presented them with a certificate that shows the establishment of this group under the leadership of Mr Alfred Galea.

This result was obtained after eight hours of examinations and hard physical and combat training. During these exams, the students were tested in stam-

ina/physical endurance and in combat techniques.

Nine students have obtained their 9th Kyu grade and Mr Alfred Grima passed to 7th Kyu with the responsibility to teach and expand the group.

The Togakure Ryu (Malta) teaches the art of the Ninja. The students of this art practise Taijutsu unarmed combat, Bonjutsu stick and staff fighting, Intonjutsu which is the art of escape and concealment which can hold as part of self defence courses and finally Kyojutsu Tenjan Ho which is the art of understanding your surroundings and the society you live in.

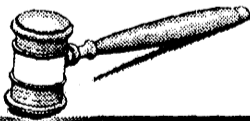
